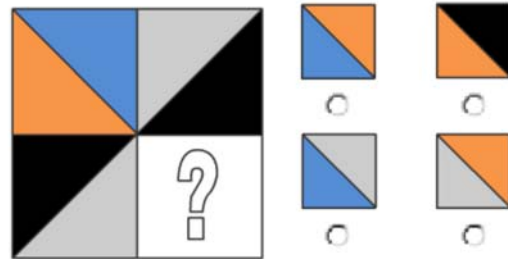

It should be clarified that the Centers for Disease Control defines heterosexual transmission as "contact with a person known to have, or to be at high risk for, HIV infection." Anyone having sex with another who does not have HIV has zero risk. It should also be noted that deaths from HIV/AIDS have plummeted over 80 percent in many states and that deaths from HIV are headed towards zero with the latest CDC report of 14,016 deaths in the 50 states. We have

contacted the Departments of Health in all fifty states and they place the number of HIV/AIDS deaths at 10,624. Diabetes kills more than HIV and breast cancer combined and cardiovascular disease kills 871,000 yet the government is spending \$3,052 on each HIV/AIDS patient in research versus \$29 on each patient with cardiovascular disease and similar small amounts on the sixteen diseases that kill more Americans than HIV disease each year. The solution to global HIV? Same as in this country: provide the prevention education and existing drugs and get them to the patients, not more, unfair research allocations.
