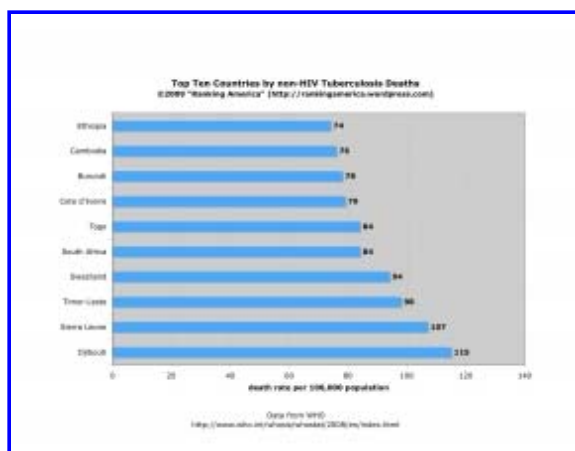

## The U.S. ranks 190th in tuberculosis deaths

According to the World Health Organization, in 2006 the mortality rate for non-HIV related tuberculosis in the United States was 0 per 100,000 population, which made the United States [tied for one-hundred and ninetieth](#), or last, in that category with Canada, Iceland, and Monaco. The country with the highest mortality rate for non-HIV related tuberculosis was Djibouti, at 115 per 100,000 population.
