- The CARE Act was originally enacted August 18, 1990 by PL 101-381. It amended the Public Health Service Act to add Title XXVI, HIV Health Care Services Program.
- The first reauthorization was enacted May 20, 1996 by PL 104-146. It also incorporated the AETCs and Dental Reimbursement Programs effective October 1, 1997 (FY 1997).
- The second reauthorization of the CARE Act was enacted October 20, 2000 by PL 106-345.

- 1 - FY 1993: Reflects mandatory appropriation-wide reductions (to nearest \$) required by PL 102-394, the FY 1993 DHHS Appropriations Act.
- 2 - FY 1999: Original appropriation reduced \$499,000 under Secretary's Appropriation Transfer authority
- 3 - FY 2000: Exempted from discretionary spending recissions required by PL 106-113, the FY 2000 DHHS Appropriations Act. Original appropriation reduced \$315,000 under Secretary's Appropriation Transfer authority
- 4 - FY 2001: Reflects administrative cost reductions mandated by PL 106-554, the FY 2001 DHHS Appropriations Act.
- 5 - FY 2002: Reflects administrative cost reductions mandated by PL 107-116, the FY 2002 DHHS Appropriations Act.
- 6 - FY 2003: Reflects recissions of 0.65% mandated by PL 108-7, the FY 2003 DHHS Appropriations Act.
- 7 - FY 2004: Reflects recissions of 0.59% and administrative reductions mandated by PL 108-199, the FY 2004 DHHS Appropriations Act
- 8 - FY 2005: Reflects recissions of 0.8.0% and administrative reductions mandated by PL 108-447, the FY 2005 DHHS Appropriations Act
- * - FY 2003, FY 2004, FY 2005 & FY 2006 SPNS: Normally funded with set-asides from Parts A, B, C, & D, Appropriation Acts have directed that SPNS shall be funded from PHS evaluation set-asides. The appropriation amounts shown reflect a proportionate redistribution of the \$25,000,000 to Parts A, B, C, & D.
